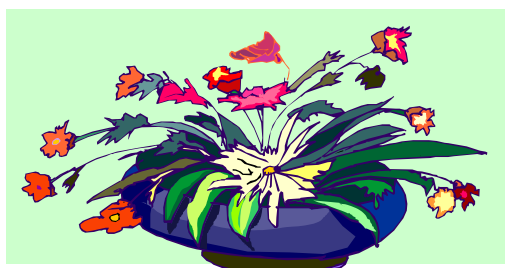

- Slacks & Shirt, Dress or Skirt & Blouse. (No shorts, swimwear or sleepwear)
- Ages 7 - 14 inclusive

CLASS K2. “ CASUAL-ACTIVE WEAR” - For Fun, Sun, Play or Sport. (No swimwear)

- Shorts/Track Pants / Skirt and Shirt/ Blouse /T Shirt
- Ages 7 - 14 years inclusive.

CLASS K3. “COSTUME PARTY” for a fancy dress /theme party (not a sleep-over)

- Costume must still follow the 50% minimum natural fibres content, but additional fabric can be used to create the desired effect. No purchased garments can be used.
- If the costume requires a mask, (eg batman) then the mask and accessories involved become part of the judged garment. Accessories must also be created by the entrant and not purchased.
- Aged 7-14 inclusive)
- Due to the complexity of these outfits, the entrant **MUST SUPPLY THEIR OWN MODEL**

CLASS K4. “SELF MADE- PRIMARY”, Any Occasion

- Ages 8 to 11 inclusive. Age to be noted on entry form.
- Garment to be cut and sewn by the entrant, but they may receive help. Outfit is not to be made by an adult.
- Garment must be modelled by the entrant

CLASS K5. “SELF MADE”, MIDDLE SCHOOL . Any Occasion

- Ages 12 - 14 inclusive,. Age of entrant to be noted on entry form A
- Garment to be cut and sewn by entrant without assistance. They may receive advise only.
- Garment must be modelled by the entrant

CLASS 7. “Wearable Art” – to be as creative as you can be

- Design ideas are only limited to your imagination , but you must explain your ideas on the entry form.
- Entrants in this class may not necessarily sew their garments, but will receive extra points if they do.

- Purchased outfits can be used and embellished.
- Any materials/etc can be used to create the required design
- You do not have to be a sewer to enter this class.
- Minimum entry age – 15 years
- Models must be 15 years or over. Please ensure that the age of the model is applicable to the type of garment, i.e. if the garment is deemed to be an adults only type outfit, then the model must be an adult.
