RULES & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY.

Please obtain the **“Natural Fibres Creations, Kids in Natural Fibres & Wearable Art” Booklet** from the Stewards or Show Secretary for the full terms & conditions of entry.

This booklet also contains the correct entry forms which must be used.

First & Second Place winners from the following classes are eligible to represent Boonah Show Society at the State Finals to be held at the Exhibition in August.

“NATURAL FIBRES CREATIONS” CLASSES

CLASS 1. SENIOR SCHOOL :- Suitable for any occasion including After 5

- Open to ages 15 & 17 years inclusive. Age of entrant to be stated on Form A.
- Fabric used in outfit to cost no more than \$150-00. Receipt to be supplied for proof of cost.
- Outfit must be modelled by the entrant

CLASS 2. OPEN “ADULT OUTFIT” DAYWEAR

- Suitable for Race Meeting, Business Meeting, Garden Party, Wedding, or any Other daytime occasion

CLASS 3. OPEN “CREATIVE OUTFIT”

Suitable for any occasion including After 5

- This is not a Wearable Art class, but entries are required to feature creativity and innovation using craft, art, machine or hand embroidery, patchwork, quilting, smocking etc, or other creative sewing technique and should have the initial visual impact of a creative entry.

CLASS 4. OPEN “ADULT OUTFIT” FORMAL WEAR

- Suitable for After 5, Cocktail, Wedding Dress, Ball etc. or any evening occasion (not sleepwear)

CLASS 5. “CALICO CAPERS” ADULT OUTFIT – Any Occasion

- All entries in this class must be made from 100% calico. (Only exceptions is linings & petticoats)
- Outfit can be for any occasion including day, evening and bridal wear.

CLASS 6. “ RESTRICTED CLASS” –

- Suitable for any occasion, including after 5
- * Open to 18 to 21 years inclusive
- Entrant must be a registered student of a Tafe/University or recognised dressmaking /fashion design facility
- Fabric used in outfit to cost no more than \$150-00. (Receipts to be supplied for proof of cost)
- Outfit must be modelled by the entrant

CLASS 7. “Wearable Art” – to be as creative as you can be

- Design ideas are only limited to your imagination , but you must explain your ideas on the entry form.
- Entrants in this class may not necessarily sew their garments, but will receive extra points if they do.
- Purchased outfits can be used and embellished.
- Any materials/etc can be used to create the required design
- You do not have to be a sewer to enter this class.
- Minimum entry age – 15 years
- Models must be 15 years or over. Please ensure that the age of the model is applicable to the type of garment, i.e. if the garment is deemed to be an adults only type outfit, then the model must be an adult.

“KIDS IN NATURAL FIBRES” CLASSES

CLASS K1 “SHOWTIME” – Party, Wedding, their first Dance, Country Show or Theatre/Movies.

- Slacks & Shirt, Dress or Skirt & Blouse. (No shorts, swimwear or sleepwear)
- Ages 7 - 14 inclusive

CLASS K2. “ CASUAL-ACTIVE WEAR” - For Fun, Sun, Play or Sport. (No swimwear)

- Shorts/Track Pants / Skirt and Shirt/ Blouse /T Shirt
- Ages 7 - 14 years inclusive.

CLASS K3. “COSTUME PARTY” for a fancy dress /theme party (not a sleep-over)

- Costume must still follow the 50% minimum natural fibres content, but additional fabric can be used to create the desired effect. No purchased garments can be used.
- If the costume requires a mask, (eg batman) then the mask and accessories involved become part of the judged garment. Accessories must also be created by the entrant and not purchased.
- Aged 7-14 inclusive)
- Due to the complexity of these outfits, the entrant **MUST SUPPLY THEIR OWN MODEL**

CLASS K4. “SELF MADE- PRIMARY”, Any Occasion

- Ages 8 to 11 inclusive. Age to be noted on entry form.
- Garment to be cut and sewn by the entrant, but they may receive help. Outfit is not to be made by an adult.
- Garment must be modelled by the entrant

CLASS K5. “SELF MADE”, MIDDLE SCHOOL . Any Occasion

- Ages 12 - 14 inclusive,. Age of entrant to be noted on entry form A
- Garment to be cut and sewn by entrant without assistance. They may receive advise only.
- Garment must be modelled by the entrant
